

# Days of the Week ימי השבוע

<b>Yom Rishon</b> <i>(first day)</i>	יום ראשון	Sunday
<b>Yom Sheni</b> <i>(second day)</i>	יום שני	Monday
<b>Yom Shlishi</b> <i>(third day)</i>	יום שלישי	Tuesday
<b>Yom Revi'i</b> <i>(fourth day)</i>	יום רביעי	Wednesday
<b>Yom Chamishi</b> <i>(fifth day)</i>	יום חמישי	Thursday
<b>Yom Shishi</b> <i>(sixth day)</i>	יום שישי	Friday
<b>Shabbat</b> <i>(Sabbath)</i>	שבת	Saturday

**Note:** In Modern Hebrew, it is common for Hebrew speakers to leave out the word "Yom" (day) when saying the days of the week. They will just say the number of the day (Ex "Rishon") for all the days.
